Awareness Program

Cyber Security, Health & Hygiene, Meditation and Yoga

An awareness program on Cyber Security, Health & Hygiene, Meditation and Yoga was conducted to educate participants about safe digital practices, personal well-being, and mental peace. The program aimed to build a holistic approach to modern lifestyle challenges by combining digital safety with physical and mental health.

- Cyber Security: To educate participants about online threats, safe browsing, password protection, phishing, and responsible social media use. Conducted by Officials' from crime branch

Key points covered:

1. Common cyber threats: phishing, malware, identity theft
2. Creating strong passwords and enabling 2-factor authentication
3. Safe use of UPI, net banking, and public Wi-Fi
4. Cyberbullying and legal provisions under IT Act 2000. A live demo on identifying fake emails and websites was shown.

Health & Hygiene

Points discussed:

1. Importance of handwashing and personal hygiene
2. Balanced diet, safe drinking water, and seasonal disease prevention
3. sanitation awareness

Meditation & Yoga: To introduce stress management techniques, benefits of daily yoga, and mindfulness for improved focus and mental health. 5-minute guided meditation for stress relief. Benefits of daily practice for students' concentration and anxiety reduction were explained.

Olympiad Examination

We successfully conducted the Olympiad Examinations for the academic year [2025-26] across multiple subjects including Science, Mathematics, English, Cyber, and General Knowledge. The exams were organized by SOF and witnessed enthusiastic participation from students of Classes [1-10].
