English

Activity -1. What's your story?

Read any one book/story of your liking and write a book review on it in the sequence given below:

- Page 1: Book cover (Make an illustration describing the book)
- Page 2: Book Title, Author's name, a synopsis(summary) of the book (word limit: 60-70)
- Page 3: Why do you like or dislike the book? (word limit: 50-60)

Note – Students can use small diary or notebook for this English Activity.

Environmental Studies

1. Plant Growth Project

Grow a small plant (such as coriander/methi/bean). Observe it daily for 10–15 days. Record its growth (height, leaves, changes). Draw pictures and write 5–6 lines about your observation.

2. Bird Watching

Observe 3–5 birds around your house. Write their names, colours and food habits. Draw or paste pictures. Keep a bowl of water for birds during summer.

3. My Surroundings

Observe your locality. Write about cleanliness and types of houses. Draw a simple map of your area.

4. Healthy Food Chart

Prepare a chart showing healthy and junk food. Write your daily diet. Include summer fruits and their benefits.

5. Importance of Trees

Write 8–10 lines on “Importance of Trees”. Draw or paste pictures. Add a slogan like “Save Trees Save Life”.

6. Journey of Food (Farm to Plate)

Question: How does food reach from farm to our plate? Draw the journey of food (Farm → Market → Home → Plate). Write the steps of the food journey. Observe the food you eat daily. Write 5–6 lines about it.

Note – Complete any two projects from the given topic. You can use A4 sheet or chart paper.
